CONDITIONS

- 1 All entries are free and open to any orchid grower.
- 2 Entries are received on the basis that the Host Society shall not be responsible for any loss, destruction or damage to such exhibits, and the exhibitor shall have no claim whatsoever against the Host Society or any of the Societies involved.
- 3 Plants competing for prizes shall have been owned by, and in the possession of the exhibitor for the preceding six months.
- 4 All plants exhibited must be healthy and free of pests and diseases. The Show Marshall's decision in this matter shall be final.
- 5 The Show Marshall reserves the right to reject, remove or rearrange any exhibit. Extra classes may be created at the discretion of the Show Marshall.
- 6 All plants entered should be correctly and clearly labeled with the name of the plant. Labels should be legible to the public. **Any plant without a label and entry number will NOT be judged.**
- 7 Judging shall be by a panel of Judges nominated by or approved by the Australian Orchid Council, and the Australian Orchid Council shall in accordance with the Standards and By-laws lay down judging. Eligible Judges to be Conference Registrants. The Judges' decision is final. No correspondence or debate will be entered into.
- 8 An exhibitor shall not remove plants, an exhibit or part thereof before the end of the show, without the permission of the Show Marshall prior to the show.
- 9 No flower or fruit, other than orchids, anthuriums or bromeliads may be used in any display.
- 10 Exhibitors may use ferns/foliage to embellish exhibits. Such plants will not be taken into consideration in judging, except for decorative effect in display classes.
- 11 Entries in Seedling Classes and Species Classes **MUST BE NOTIFIED TO THE SHOW MARSHALL**, not later than 7pm on the last day of the Set Up. Seedlings and species orchids not correctly nominated will not be judged.
- 12 A seedling shall mean the complete plant grown from seed, flowering for the first time. It shall retain its seedling status throughout the flowering season in which it first flowered.
- 13 Cut racemes are only eligible for Grand Champion, Champion Hybrid, Champion Species and Champion Cut Cymbidium and Champion Cut Raceme.
- 14 The Host Society reserves the right to photograph, for its own purposes, any exhibit in the Show.
- 15 Unless otherwise specified, all Classes are for Hybrids only.
- 16 Display positions will be balloted and must be manned during judging.
- 17 The judging panel will decide if a plant benched in a species class is a species. No correspondence will be entered into where the panel is not satisfied a plant is a species.

FLORAL ART SECTION - Conditions for competition

- 1. All entries must be notified 1 month prior to show
- 2. Orchids must predominate, but other flowers/foliage may be used
- 3. No artificial plant material allowed
- 4. Each class to be judged accordingly to its principals and element
- 5. Classes 174 – 180 will be staged on a bench, with a space for each entry of 750mm x 750mm with exhibit to take up an area no more than 2/3rds of space allocated for each exhibit.
- 6. Floor displays -no more than 3 people working on one display - Class 181
- 7. All exhibits to be viewed all around
